Footnotes

MINSTREL NOTES rated a clear lead off the rail, came under pressure leaving the turn and held well under steady stretch encouragement. PIEDMONT'S PRIZE chased the pace outside, entered the stretch about the eight path and dug in from there to get place late yards. CAPE CIDE CHARMER gave chase from the inside but flattened stride late stretch. LUV WINS engaged in close early chase toward mid track, held aim while saving ground into the turn then leveled off the final sixteenth. MIDSUMMER LADY chased the leaders erratically through the backstretch, entered the stretch about the seven path and had little further in the lane. PROSPECTIVE PEACE ducked in at the start, gave chase inside through the backstretch, lost some ground leaving the turn then lugged in while leveling off. SKIP THE LIMIT chased the pace toward the outside, entered the stretch about the seven path then lugged in while leveling off. MAKE MOM PROUD chased the early pace off the rail, bore outward nearing the quarter pole, corrected course into the turn but had nothing further in the lane. WELCOMECAT DIAMOND was no factor toward mid track.
