Footnotes

MORT ROBBINS prompted the issue three wide, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch, slowly inched clear under a strong drive. MALA MALA CAT set the pace while under heavy pressure, dug in around the turn, finished willingly. MAKE A WESH bore out at the start, moved up three and four wide to become a factor but lacked a closing bid. LOGANS LIL DEVIL forced the issue just off the rail, lacked a late response. CLASSICAL CHARMER pressed the pace from the inside, remained a factor on the turn, lacked the needed late rally. SIR AMAKUS four wide down the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, never threatened in the drive. POSTAGE PAID forced out and steadied at the start, was no factor three wide. RUNAGAINSTTHERULES was used up after a half, three and four wide. KING'S RANSOM three wide along the backstretch, pulled up on the turn and was vanned off after the finish.
