Footnotes

GIFT OF VALOR settled off the pace in the two path early, advanced four wide around the far turn and closed with a rush to get up in the final strides. ISLAND SKY stalked the pace two wide between rivals around the first turn, bid two wide nearing the far turn, took command midway through that bend, drew clear in upper stretch, lugged out under strong right-handed urging and led to deep stretch. GERRYMANDER set the pace just off the rail, was collared midway around the far turn and weakened in the lane. AMERICAN STEEL stalked the pace from the rail, swung four wide leaving the quarter pole and rallied mildly through the lane. TOBE SUAVE bobbled just after the start, was bumped soon after, lacked speed along the rail, raced in the two path entering the far turn, was pushed five wide when AMERICAN STEEL swung out leaving the quarter pole and lacked the needed rally. RICH DISCOVERY raced two wide between rivals early, came five wide around the far turn and failed to menace. ADDICTED TO WEALTH never factored while racing three and four wide. LOVE ME LATER bumped TOBE SUAVE early, prompted the pace three wide and tired after a half.
