Footnotes

MAXIMOSO stalked the pace from the rail, tipped two wide midway around the far turn, steadily gained in upper stretch, took the lead near the sixteenth pole and quickly cleared. PERFECTITUDE set the pace in the two path, drew clear around the far turn, led until midstretch while continuing on his left lead and just lasted for the place. GAMBERONI had his head turned at the start, lagged inside, advanced along the rail around the far turn and finished well on his left lead. RUTLEDGE STAR was unhurried while racing two wide early, went five wide around the far turn and rallied belatedly. D K'S WILDCAT settled off the pace while racing four wide around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, bid three wide into the far turn and came up empty from the three-sixteenths pole. PURELY BUSINESS prompted the pace three wide and tired after a half. SELF DEALIN' MAN never factored while racing four and five wide. BIG JIMMY J. had brief speed three wide and raced six wide around the far turn.
