**Footnotes**

KID COTTON rated a clear pace inside, widened through the final turn, was driven in the upper stretch then allowed to relax late. LOOPHOLE stalked the winner three wide, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, proved no match for that one and had to settle for second best. FOXFIELD DRIVE rated close to the early pace off the rail but showed no response from the five sixteenths pole. PETE'S THUNDER made a mild bid off the rail from the five sixteenths pole after racing well back inside. Q DAWG, well back, made a mild four wide bid from the five sixteenths pole. CHESTNUT PRIZE, six wide the opening turn, moved to the inside through the front stretch and saved ground to no effect. CLAYSGATOR N BEARS saved ground off the pace and faded on the final turn. GUSTO AT DAWN faded after a half mile while saving ground. MRCAT N USFASHIONS steadied early and was not a factor.
