Footnotes

THANKSFORTHEDRINK chased the early pace about the three path, eased out from the three sixteenths pole, entered the stretch in the five path and dug in from there to get up late yards. ROMAN REWARDS pressured the pace two deep, was carried out while taking the lead leaving the turn then caught in late yards. GRACEFUL GALE chased the pace from the inside, had aim a furlong away but leveled off late yards. PAGE'S PROMISE was hustled along with a slim advantage off the rail nearing the three eighths pole, set a pressured pace from that point, lost some ground into the lane and leveled off from there. MISS JOHANN'S KEE gave chase toward mid track and had little left in the stretch. SCARLET HALL gave chase toward the outside and never factored. BABY BUBBLES chased the early pace widest then saved ground on the turn.
