Footnotes

IN THE BUBBLES prompted the issue three wide, rallied to a clear lead around the turn then prevailed while kept to steady urging through the lane. HIGHNTHESKYMERCURY off the pace four wide, made his bid on the turn and held second under strong urging. FURRFIELD CAT hit the gate at the start, was lugging out down the backstretch eight wide, came five wide around the turn and finished strongly through the stretch. JAMES WOOD stalked the leaders just off the rail, lacked a closing bid when asked in the drive. HOLY ROLL'EM forced the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. THE DEVIL YOU SAY set the pace inside, opened a clear lead down the backstretch, remained a factor on the turn, gave way in the drive. REGAL JESTER flashed early speed along the rail but was used up after a half. NEW MOON BEAM hopped at the start, was five wide along the backstretch while never threatening.
