MAY KING settled close to the early pace about the three path, pulled himself to the front nearing the three eighths pole, was soon clear from there, widened rounding the final turn, drifted into the lane but held on under steady urging. BROOKS IN TOWN rated back from the early pace off the rail, started a bid at the five sixteenths pole, was steadily improving and finished well. ROADHOUSE ROMEO rated off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole and improved position to the middle of the final turn before leveling off. LUMINOUS TIMES rated back inside, eased outward through the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and finished evenly. PLEASANT GALLOP raced well back inside. BLUESIDE rated with the early pace two deep, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn. COMEONSATURDAY rated with the early pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn.
