**Footnotes**

HIGHNTHESKYMERCURY settled well back inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased around a tired rival midway through the final turn then dug in at the rail from the head of the lane to take over and draw clear from the sixteenth pole. GATOR DONE stalked the pace two deep, challenged past the three eighths pole, contested the final turn then bested the pacesetter inside the sixteenth pole while overcome for the win. KING OF BOP, off the pace toward mid track, bid at the five sixteenths pole, came through the final turn about the four path then outfinished in the duel for show. SIR RAYFORD, off the pace outside, bid from the half mile pole, was in the five path on the final turn and finished evenly. JUST FUHR REAL moved to a slim lead inside approaching the first turn, rated to the three eighths pole, was pressured at that point, contested the rail through the final turn, yielded control midstretch and weakened approaching the wire. CLINK CLINK CLINK stalked the pace about the three path, gave chase from the three eighths pole but leveled off through the final turn. ROCKINGGLENROY ran well back inside. VISION WITHINREACH stumbled leaving the gate, settled close to the early pace inside, gave chase from the three eighths pole then faded nearing the final turn. QUICK SHOW was not a factor outside. BANNER TIME was through after three eighths.
