Footnotes

JOHNNY JOE settled back saving ground, bid toward the quarter pole, came between horses leaving the turn, took over approaching the sixteenth pole and was steadily handled to widen. GARNERED ICE chased the pace toward mid track, entered the stretch five wide and dug in from there to take the nod for place. BAY BUTTON BILL gave distant chase under a steady drive, found his best stride leaving the turn, was gaining steadily through the lane and just missed the nod for place. HOLD THE LINE was hustled to the front past the half mile pole to set a pressured pace inside, was caught nearing the sixteenth pole and leveled off from there. WHAT A PRINCE chased the pace inside and had aim at the head of the lane but flattened stride the final sixteenth. CRACK THEPAT gave chase from the outside, rounded the turn six wide and leveled off down the lane. RAINBOW INTHESTORM gave close chase through the backstretch, rounded the turn four wide and weakened in the lane. BORN TO CUS was outrun mid track.
