WILDCAT WIDOW set the pace on the rail, widened around the turn, bore out into the stretch, was straightened then prevailed while kept to strong urging. COCORITE forced the pace four wide down the backstretch, moved to the inside on the turn and was slowly gaining in the stretch. GYMNIST JACK bid three wide around the turn and finished well. SUNSHINE AND STORM close up along the rail, lacked a late response. GLADYS PEMBROKE stalked the pace three and four wide, failed to respond. PISTOL POWER failed to menace four wide. ANOTHER TRUE MANOR saved ground to no avail. TWO HOPE DIAMONDS showed little inside. THIRD TRY was no factor. LEVEL LADY had little impact.
