**Footnotes**

DI COLAS DREAM dueled just outside of D K'S WILDCAT, inched away from that rival near the three-sixteenths pole, drifted in in upper stretch, then dug in gamely when challenged by MYSTICAL MOON in deep stretch to prevail. MYSTICAL NOTION stalked the leaders four wide around the first turn, moved up outside down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the far turn, then finished well through the lane. CHICKEN POWER was bumped just after the start, was unhurried while saving ground through the opening half, advanced inside around the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, then finished willingly between rivals. WON MY AFFAIR was bumped just after the start, lacked speed four wide, moved up outside down the backstretch, continued to race four wide around the far turn, then finished fastest of all on the far outside through the lane. MATTHEW'S PRIDE prompted the pace from the rail, dropped back while racing three wide around the far turn, lacked a late response. D K'S WILDCAT set a pressured pace along the rail, vied inside the winner down the backstretch, then gave way near the three-sixteenths pole. WELCOME HARBOR was never a threat. WAY WEST WAR showed brief speed inside. SAGAN SLEW forced the issue two and three wide, tired around the far turn. THEPOWERSINYOU was never a factor after being fractious in the starting gate.
