**Footnotes**

VIVO lagged along the inside around the first two turns, advanced outside down the backstretch, circled five wide around the far turn, closed on his left lead and was up in deep stretch. TURF COUNT stalked the pace three wide, vied between rivals down the backstretch, continued to battle inside around the far turn, edged clear entering the lane, continued on his left lead and led until deep stretch. REFLECTED AFFAIR settled off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and was along for the show. GANGA lacked speed, advanced inside around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. CLARKE COUNTY checked entering the first turn, steadily advanced three wide, reached near even terms midway down the backstretch, vied outside of TURF COUNT around the far turn then weakened in the lane. SOUND AFFAIR stalked the pace three wide around the first turn, angled to the rail the first time through the stretch, raced three wide around the far turn and lacked a rally. DANCING VALIANT set the pace in the two path and tired midway down the backstretch. GHOSTLY THUNDER saved ground early and never factored.
