HOT INCLUSION moved up three wide down the backstretch, rallied around the turn, split foes in late stretch to be up in the final strides. MALIBU KITTEN prompted the issue just off the rail, gained a slim lead at the top of the stretch, missed in a game effort. TRUE ZIP off a step slow, advanced along the inside, was on even terms into the stretch but came up short in a strong effort. BELLA COLES three and four wide, closed with a rush through the lane. ANGEL LISA set the pace on the rail, dug in down the backstretch, gave way around the turn. BARI THE QUEEN within striking distance from the inside, failed to respond. MAUD G stalked the leaders along the inside but was used up after three quarters. DOT'S DREAM pressed the pace three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn, never threatened in the drive.
