GO ROSE forced the pace just off the rail, loomed boldly around the turn, flattened out. LADY AFLAIR advanced along the inside, failed to sustain his bid. HOME DEED saved ground, rallied three wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. JUDGE'S APPEAL found his best stride late from the rail. NIMMER with the pace on the rail, lacked the needed rally. SISTY ANNE stalked the pace three and four wide, failed to respond. SAINTS AND SAGES was no factor four and five wide. HIDDEN set the pace for a half, tired. GRINAMIC was used up after a half.
