TWENTY HAWKS was jostled after the start, stalked the pace three wide, took over near the five-sixteenths pole, vied inside of rivals while racing in the two path around that bend, inched away nearing the lane and held sway under a drive while drifting out in the lane. DONTSELLMETOFELONS rated off the pace in the two path around the first turn, remained unhurried while racing four wide around the clubhouse turn, responded when roused at the three-eighths pole with a quick surge into contention entering the far turn, vied three wide around that bend but was second best in the lane. PAGAN CAT was caught five wide around the first turn, stalked the pace three wide around the clubhouse turn, bid outside of the winner nearing the far turn, vied between rivals in the three path from the quarter pole past the three-sixteenths marker, came up empty nearing the lane and held third while continuing on his left lead through the stretch. PROUD PLUCK was bumped after the start, lacked speed two and three wide and passed tiring rivals. PURELY BUSINESS was caught four wide between rivals around the first turn, raced in within striking distance for three-quarters and faded from there. REDMAN'S HATCH set the pace along the rail and faltered after three-quarters. WINDSOR CITY had brief speed inside, stopped and was eased.
