CHARMING TRIP stalked the pacesetter, made a menacing bid at the top of the lane, wore down rival. ZIG ZAG BETTY sprinted to a long lead, led into the stretch, faded late. FLIP LIP was slow to begin, found her best stride late and was gaining through the stretch. ANOTHER UNA in good position off the leaders, did not respond when set down for the drive. TEN COINS settled in the middle of the field, raced evenly. IRISH LASSIE was unhurried early, passed tiring rivals late. MIZ BUFF, allowed to settle, was in tight quarters and forced to steady at the top of the lane. CANADIAN FLAGSHIP was no factor. O'LARCAIN had early speed, chased the pacesetter, was used up from her early efforts. TAPIOCA was through early.
