Footnotes

BAY BUTTON BILL set the pace on the rail, held clear under steady urging. MAJOR DANGER advanced three wide, bid around the turn and was clearly second best. TAPAZOZ moved up three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. DEEP IMPACT saved ground, rallied four wide around the turn, failed to sustain his bid. SIR PAUL THAU bumped at the start, was five wide along the backstretch, eased down three wide on the turn then was no threat in the drive. MR. ORIENTATE bumped then in tight at the start, failed to menace inside. DUCKHORN'S JOY bore out and bumped with MR. ORIENTATE at the start, never was a factor three wide. STORM JUMPER bid along the inside down the backstretch, flattened out. YARROW'S CAT showed early speed, had little left after a half. FAMOUS GENTLEMAN flashed brief foot inside.
