COASTAL DRIVE was unhurried along the inside through the opening half, advanced between rivals down the backstretch, rallied three wide around the far turn, came very wide into the lane, closed powerfully on the far outside, swept to command leaving the sixteenth pole and quickly drew clear. BOB BOB'S BOY set the pace well off the rail, was collared inside the sixteenth pole and was well clear of the rest. SKIP TO THE NORTH settled off the pace, raced four wide throughout and was along for the show. BORN TO CUS chased the pace four wide and came up empty. BURNT OFFERING was a bit rank early, raced two and three wide and failed to menace. ZIO TONY stalked the pace three wide and was used up after three-quarters. FIRST AND BAY trailed well off the rail.
