**Footnotes**

CATCHPENNY LASS rated a clear lead off the rail, was driven into the stretch and held on well. STERLING GIRLPOWER chased the pace three wide but leveled off nearing the wire. ZIPPY JAN broke in making contact with Idontgetoutmuch, gave distant chase in mid track, improved position seven wide on the turn then found her best stride through the lane. LIL MISS FOXFIELD chased the pace from the inside, eased to the three path into the stretch then leveled off toward the wire. IDONTGETOUTMUCH, pinched back at the start, closed to the heels of Ready Two Punch midway on the turn, steadied angling in at that point then leveled off through the lane. SAY WHAT YOU WANT, briefly close early, chased the pace toward mid track down the backstretch, faded to last approaching the turn but came back with a mild resurgent stretch bid. READY TWO PUNCH broke out making contact with Idontgetoutmuch, chased the pace off the rail then flattened stride three wide on the turn. IT'S TIME TO WIN gave chase off the rail then faded through the lane. RITZY STORED chased the early pace three wide then weakened losing ground on the turn. PYRAMIDRIVE chased the pace toward mid track then faded saving ground on the turn.
