Footnotes

SHOP SMART stalked the pace three wide, took command near the three-sixteenths pole and drew clear under a drive in the lane. RUTLEDGE LION pressed the pace two wide, vied outside down the backstretch, led, entering the far turn, could not keep pace with the winner from the three-sixteenths pole and lasted for the place. BIGUM was devoid of speed while racing two and three wide early, advanced four wide around the far turn and just missed second. BEAU AMERICAN lacked speed inside, advanced four wide around the far turn and lacked the needed rally. PRIVATE NOTICE was reluctant to load, set the pace along the rail and gave way entering the far turn. LITTLE FEAT failed to menace while racing two wide. SWAGGABOY was never a factor while racing two wide.
