Footnotes

YOUNIQUE CAT set the pace along the rail, edged clear leaving the half-mile pole, drew off around the far turn and widened under a drive in the lane. I GOT'M lacked speed, saved ground early, advanced three wide around the far turn, drifted in under left-handed urging in the lane and was clearly second best. KINSTAR lacked speed along the rail, advanced three wide down the backstretch, angled back to the rail nearing the lane and was along for the show. CUT THE CORNER pressed the pace two wide and tired around the far turn. PREFERRED BEHAVIOR failed to menace while racing three and four wide. PROCRUSTES was not a factor while racing three and four wide. UNSHATTERABLE chased the pace five wide around the first turn and steadily faded while racing three wide thereafter.
