Footnotes

SEEKING MILLIE, in tight between horses on the front stretch, angled five wide into the opening turn, settled off the pace off the rail down the backstretch, made a bid toward the quarter pole, eased out through the final turn, entered the stretch three wide and steadily closed to get up late yards. STEALING MONEY was forced six wide into the first turn, settled close to the pace in mid track, accelerated to the lead three wide near the five sixteenths pole, dueled clear on the final turn and dug in with the advantage to late stretch before being overcome. MEG'S MONSTER BABY stalked the pace two deep, moved to a slim brief lead between horses approaching the five sixteenths pole, gave chase through the final turn but leveled off down the lane. EXPENSIVE GIFT settled off the pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased out entering the stretch then leveled off late. BLUE RIDGE CONCERN, well back inside, made a mild bid at the rail rounding the final turn then proved empty in the stretch. SHEZAGOODEGG took the early lead inside entering the first turn, rated clear past the five eighths pole, came under pressure at the three eighths pole, was overcome nearing the final turn then weakened in the stretch. FINE CASHMERE raced well back inside and had no rally. MOLINARO BELLISIMA, off the pace and off the rail, weakened after a half mile. HIT BY A HURRICANE, four wide early, was through after a half mile. SHE WANTS TO KNOW stalked the pace about the three path then gave way on the final turn.
