Footnotes

CAT'S LAST TANGO, five wide the opening turn, rated close to the early pace toward mid track, responded to rider's pressure toward the five sixteenths pole, took over two deep nearing the quarter, was soon clear and widened under steady stretch handling. DANCE TICKET steadied into the first turn, settled off the early pace off the rail, eased toward mid track into the backstretch, angled out with a bid past the seven sixteenths pole, saved some ground on the final turn but entered the stretch five wide and duelled for place a sixteenth away. UPTOWN AMBER took the lead two deep past the half mile pole, came under pressure at the three eighths, was caught into the final turn then outfinished for place midstretch. HAVENS TESTAMONY, awkward at the break, kept close to the pace four wide the opening turn, eased six wide with a bid nearing the five sixteenths pole then saved ground leveling off on the final turn. HAVING A BALL raced six wide the opening turn, settled outside on the backstretch, bid from the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn seven wide and passed tired rivals outside. MR. MAC'S COLLEEN raced boxed inside the opening turn while settling close to the early pace off the rail, gave chase from the nine sixteenths pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. FINE CASHMERE took a brief lead inside, was caught past the half mile pole and continued a close factor to the five sixteenths before fading. ELEGANT DIAMOND, well back saving ground early, moved to the outside leaving the first turn and was not a factor. FAR SOUTH was shuffled back early and was no factor saving ground.
