Footnotes

HOT SAUCE stalked the early pace off the rail, moved alongside three wide near the half mile pole, came in a path at the three eighths pole, dueled to the lead toward the final turn, lost ground entering the stretch but dug in under steady encouragement to last. KATHLEENS A CATCH stalked the early pace inside, was boxed near the rail through the second turn, shut off checking at the three eighths pole, gave chase from that point, eased out through the final turn, had aim at the three sixteenths pole, carried out entering the stretch and closed well to the winner's withers before running out of ground. BAYONNE settled back toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved some ground on the final turn and finished well. L P'S TIGER rated close about the three path, moved to the lead two deep at the half mile pole, came under pressure a furlong later, contested a slight disadvantage through the final turn, briefly recovered control at the head of the lane but weakened from the sixteenth pole. SILVER BAG settled close to the pace off the rail, made a bid at the three eighths pole and gave close chase to the quarter pole before fading. ALLIE'S THE BOSS dropped back early under firm restraint and was not a factor. ROCKING LADY rated close toward mid track, bid leaving the three eighths pole but had no further response on the final turn. EASILY DISTRACTED raced well back in mid track. CIRCUS TIGER had a slim lead off the rail, yielded control at the half mile pole and quickly gave way. An inquiry and subsequent claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, resulted in the former being disqualified to second for coming across the path of the latter near the three eighths pole.
