OLE ROCKY TOP saved ground down the backstretch, swung out three wide on the turn, was set down for the drive and caught INDIAN QUEST nearing the wire to be up in time. JACKPOT JANET well placed on the rail, rallied three wide around the turn, closed with a rush through the lane to just miss. INDIAN QUEST bumped with D J BAILEY at the start and again shortly after, set the pace while kept three wide, dug in when challenge in the stretch and came up short at the end in a strong effort. JOZIE GEN made a steady advance along the rail and finished strongly through the lane. GRENADA PAT pressed the pace from the rail, was still in contention on the turn, raced evenly through the stretch. D J BAILEY off a step slow and bumped at the start, was bumped and squeezed back shortly after and taken out five wide, finished well in the drive. LIL MISS FOXFIELD within striking distance three and four wide, finished with good energy. MADAME GAYLORD bumped after the start, was five and six wide and failed to menace.
