Footnotes

LITE THE HARBOR set the pace along the rail, quickly drew clear down the backstretch, remained clear to upper stretch, drifted in nearing the sixteenth pole forcing PARTY ALL NIGHT to alter course, just lasted under a strong drive. PARTY ALL NIGHT prompted the pace in the two path, angled to the rail in upper stretch, was forced to alter course when LITE THE HARBOR came in near the sixteenth pole then finished strongly outside of that rival through the final sixteenth. SPANISH AFFAIR bumped leaving the chute, stalked outside down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the turn then finished well through the lane. CHAIN SAW KING moved up in the two path around the turn, finished evenly while continuing on his left lead through the lane. ZION'S TREASURE stalked the leaders three wide, lacked a late response. CHILLY NIGHT made little impact while racing four wide. MAJOR RICK was bumped several times leaving the chute and was never a threat. WIN FOREST WIN bumped early, failed to menace thereafter. SOUND AFFAIR was never a factor while racing four wide. CHAPARRO prompted the pace from the rail, tired around the turn. The rider of PARTY ALL NIGHT lodged an objection against LITE THE HARBOR, alleging interference in mid stretch. After a review, the Stewards disqualified LITE THE HARBOR from first and placed him second.
