Footnotes

MISSY KIM set the pace along the rail, went clear near the three-sixteenths pole and drew off under a drive. RACINGMOLLYGREEN settled off the pace while racing two wide around the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn, never threatened the winner but finished well to gain the place. EVENINGOFPLEASURE pressed the pace just outside of the winner, could not keep pace with that foe from the three-sixteenths pole but finished willingly to preserve the show. PASSIONATE SPEAKER lacked speed along the inside, advanced inside around the far turn, vied along the rail for the minor awards and was outfinished. MOON DROP lacked speed, raced two and three wide and failed to menace. MY REWARD was within range while racing two wide and lacked room through the final sixteenth. DESERT BABY raced three wide around the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and never factored. I GOT A ANSWER was outrun while racing two and three wide. SPLASH OF CASH stalked the pace from the rail and was done after a half.
