SOUTHERN FOLLY rated a clear pace inside, came under a drive near the quarter pole, widened through the final turn and held well with steady encouragement. WILD CAPTAIN BOB, squeezed at the start, stalked the winner off the rail, chased that one from the three eighths pole but had to settle for second best. KINGSPIEL, unhurried inside, eased out with a bid toward the quarter pole, rounded the final turn three wide and was along late for show. MINGUNS PROSPECT came in at the break making contact with Wild Captain Bob, settled off the pace off the rail then had no response through the final turn. MIRACLE CREEK bobbled leaving the gate, made a mild outside bid past the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground on the final turn and had nothing further in the lane. FALSE DILEMMA was bumped at the break and raced well back. MOLINARO REMARKS settled back inside and never factored. MUGSY DEHERE settled off the pace about the three path and never factored. RUM DIARY rated close to the early pace inside but faded leaving the first turn.
