Footnotes

SMOKING GREEN stalked the pace off the rail, took the lead midway on the turn, was urged clear through the upper stretch and finished under mostly a hand ride. SURPRISE ATTACK chased the pace off the rail, eased to the four path into the lane and dueled for place in late yards. WHY NOT JOHN chased the early pace inside, eased to the three path at the head of the lane then outfinished in the duel for place. CAPTAIN KIRKLAND gave distant chase off the rail and finished evenly. PADDY'S DEPUTY came away awkwardly, was hustled to the lead while angling inward, set the pace inside to the quarter pole, yielded the advantage on the turn but remained close to the top of the stretch before giving way. BIG SHOTOFTEQUILA chased the pace outside then leveled off through the turn. FLAT BROWN chased the pace in mid track then weakened five wide from the head of the lane. MR. ETHAN was shuffled back early. I'M A TERP engaged in close early chase outside then weakened six wide on the turn. GRAND FAMILY was no factor racing well back.
