DAYLIGHT pressed the pace just off the rail, gained the lead on the turn, drew off under a drive. PLUCKY DISCOVERY four wide down the backstretch, rallied along the inside around the turn, finished well. SUAVE PRINCESS set the pace on a long lead for a half, gave way on the turn. MELEIUM stalked the pace between horses, made a mild gain in the stretch. POMERANZE (IRE) prompted the pace three wide, lacked a late response. PRESS BEYOND forced the pace from the rail, lacked a closing bid. SHE'S A DEPUTY saved ground to no avail.
