Footnotes

TIN PAN ALLEY CAT stalked the pace three wide, took the lead two wide near the quarter pole, was confronted by NOAH'S HARVEST soon after, edged clear turning for home, drifted out left-handed urging in the lane and held sway. NOAH'S HARVEST bobbled at the start, raced three wide throughout, bid leaving the quarter pole and finished willingly while unable to make a serious dent in the winner's margin. ALLEGHENY JACK stalked the pace two and three wide and lacked the needed rally. QUAIL HOLLOW was wide entering the first turn but angled in near the five-eighths pole to save ground most of the way, went three wide around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane and had a mild rally. WYATT'S HOPE failed to menace while racing four wide. ALL MYSELF pressed the pace inside and tired after three furlongs. IGON set the pace two wide between rivals around the first turn, was collared entering the far turn and faltered.
