SURPRISE BUDDY settled off the pace while racing three wide around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, seized command three wide leaving the quarter pole and drew off under a drive. LONG SHADOW settled just off the pace in the two path, could not match strides with the winner around the far turn but finished willingly to gain the place. EXPLOSIVE WHIRL was unhurried while racing three wide around the first turn, advanced five wide around the far turn and was along for the show. GOLD BITTEN TIGER failed to menace while racing two and three wide. LAGI LAGI broke slow, saved ground and was never a factor. ROBB'S WARRIOR set a pressured pace along the rail and gave way leaving the quarter pole. FLAVORED PUNCH broke awkwardly, saved ground early, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. SALTY EMPEROR pressed the pace two wide and faltered around the far turn.
