**Footnotes**

HONKYTONK STOMP set the pace along the rail, drew off leaving the quarter pole and widened through the lane while steadily drifting out under left-handed urging. U BOAT ALLEY lacked speed, raced along the rail and was along for the place. CANDY HEART chased the pace two wide and weakened in the lane. CAPE SABLE chased the pace three wide and came up empty while continuing on his left lead in the lane. ROYAL EAVESDROPPER failed to menace while racing three wide. READY THE CONFETTI trailed off the rail.
