Footnotes

GENTLEMAN JOHN rated close about the three path, was urged from the five sixteenths pole, dueled to the lead two deep past the three sixteenths pole, lost some ground while drawing clear into the lane and held well with steady encouragement. TYLER'S JEWEL settled back inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, was blocked leaving the final turn but dug in off the rail to duel for place inside the sixteenth pole. FLATWOOD HANK settled close off the rail, bid saving ground past the three sixteenths pole, had aim at the top of the stretch, leveled off from there and was outfinished for place. I'M NOT A BABY settled back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole and ran evenly down the lane. SPLENDID APPEAL stalked the pace two deep, challenged past the half mile pole, took the lead a furlong later, moved clear toward the final turn, kept the advantage to just inside the three sixteenths pole but lost ground weakening into the stretch. FORT APACHE STAR, well back inside, angled four wide through the final turn and had little left in the lane. JAZZ SEEKER, four wide the opening turn, was outrun toward the outside. AIR WOLF was not a factor. GOLDEN BISCUIT rated a short lead inside, yielded control nearing the three eighths pole then faded approaching the final turn. PAPPA'S HOME was through early while saving ground.
