Footnotes

HUNTER'S HOLLOW stalked the pace from the inside, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, swept to the front midway on the final turn, drifted out entering the stretch but dug in under determined handling to recover the edge later yards and drew clear under the wire. RICH MAN PALACE sprinted clear to rate the pace inside came under pressure toward the quarter pole, was caught midway on the final turn, briefly recovered control while Hunter's Hollow drifted into the lane but was outfinished from the sixteenth pole. BROOKLYN LEGEND, just off the pace about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn about the four path, dueled for show midstretch then leveled off nearing the wire. CONWAY HILLBILLY settled back inside, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole then outfinished for show. PAINTED OCEAN saved ground into the opening turn, raced well off the pace in the three and four paths, started a bid at the three eighths pole, angled out into the lane and leveled off from there. BELTWAY BANDIT steadied racing wide into the first turn. ENDANGERED SPECIES chased the early pace four wide, faded leaving the first turn and had no further response.
