**Footnotes**

VIVO clipped the heels of Singin The Blues near the rail into the first turn, settled back outside down the backstretch, bid saving some ground toward the five sixteenths pole, lost considerable momentum behind a wall of horses into the stretch, angled six wide at that point and rallied to the front in late yards to prove much the best. SINGIN THE BLUES had his heels clipped while near the rail into the first turn, settled close to the pace about the four path, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to the lead midway on the final turn, dug in with the advantage through the lane but was caught in late yards. RADNOR ROAD broke awkwardly brushing the gate, settled well back inside, came under a drive near the rail toward the quarter pole, eased out through the final turn, was seven wide into the stretch, closed steadily from there, just missed place but was outfinished for the win. TURF COUNT rated close about the three path, bid from the three eighths pole, was shuffled back in mid turn, shut off entering the stretch but kept close aim to the wire. IN CONFIDENCE, off the pace outside, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and dueled close to midstretch before leveling off. GENERAL RUTLEDGE stalked the pace off the rail, challenged the pacesetter leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim brief lead nearing the quarter pole but drifted outward while losing control midway on the turn, steadied from between horses into the stretch and weakened. TROUBLE MAKIN rated a slim lead inside, was pressured from the three eighths pole, yielded control toward the quarter but continued to give close chase through the final turn before weakening. ANZIO ADAM steadied from the heels of Trouble Makin while being taken out a path into the first turn, raced boxed at the rail through the turn, gave chase inside through the backstretch then faded on the final turn.
