SUNSHINE LISA set the pace along the rail, drew clear nearing the far turn, drew off around that bend then widened under a drive through the lane. MELODAR was unhurried inside early, eased outside down the backstretch, rallied three wide around the far turn then finished well through the lane to gain the place in the final strides. IT'S A MIRACLE forced the issue from the inside, bid inside down the backstretch, could not match strides with the winner around the far turn then lost second in the final strides. WAY TO FLY raced three wide around the first two turns, bid outside down the backstretch, could not keep pace with the winner while continuing three wide around the far turn, then finished evenly through the lane. KISS MY BRASS was devoid of speed through the opening three-quarters then passed tiring rivals. HASTA LA PASTA was never a factor. MAMA'S FIND pressed the pace four wide around the first turn, continued to apply pressure in the two path around the clubhouse turn, tired down the backstretch. GO LUV stalked the pace while caught five wide around the first turn, eased inside nearing the clubhouse turn, bid between rivals down the backstretch then stopped nearing the far turn.
