**Footnotes**

BOLD ABBOTT was unhurried along the rail through the opening half, rallied along the rail around the far turn, eased three wide leaving the three-sixteenths pole, was carried seven wide into the lane, took the lead in upper stretch then drove clear. VALARS raced in the two path while content to stay in mid pack early, advanced while still just off the rail around the far turn, got through inside in upper stretch and finished well through the lane. DRAFT PICK steadied off heels entering the first turn, stalked the dueling leaders in the two path around that bend, rallied just outside the winner around the far turn, dropped back when forced to sharply alter course nearing the lane, then finished evenly on his left lead. ANOTHER VOW was unhurried while racing three wide through the opening half, made a mild three wide rally around the far turn then improved his position in the lane. ALYJEN'S SPEED set the pace along the rail, dueled inside of HUBBERT'S PEAK down the backstretch and around the far turn then tired in the lane. LION HEART VICTORY failed to menace. HUBBERT'S PEAK pressed the pace in the two path, dueled outside of LION HEART VICTORY from the half-mile pole to the stretch, ducked out nearing the lane then tired through the stretch. JOEL'S TOUCH was never a factor. J T MOORE went to his nose at the start, quickly recovered to show some early speed then steadily faded. GOODIE'S LION showed little.
