MALIBU KITTEN with the leaders three wide, made the lead on the turn dropping to the rail, held clear through the stretch under a drive. TRUE ZIP forced the issue three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. BELLA COLES saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn, had aim at the top of the stretch but hung in the drive. MAUD G kept five wide, lacked a late response. ANGEL LISA pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked the needed rally. PELT THE FLANK up close along the rail, eased out four wide on the turn, lacked a late bid. PERFECTABLE set the pace under heavy pressure, gave way around the turn. MINDTRIP crowded shortly after the start, was no factor along the inside. FLOSSIE M. a pace factor four and five wide, tired. DUE TO A TIMER MALFUNCTION THE SPLITS AND FINAL TIME WERE HANDED TIMED.
