Footnotes

DON'T TOUCHMYSTUFF set the pace along the rail, drew off in upper stretch and held clear under a drive. ZITHER SONG was rank at the start, rushed up inside, tipped two wide to stalk the pace around the turn, could not gain on the winner but finished well to preserve the place. AMBIGUOUS chased the pace three wide and finished evenly. FORMAL ARGUMENT was bumped just after the start, raced three wide around the turn and lacked the needed rally. MISTER FIPS (IRE) never seriously threatened while racing two wide between rivals. MAXIMUM PLAN was bumped just after the start, lacked speed while racing three and four wide and improved his position in the lane. EASTER JELLY BEAN was off a step slow, advanced along the rail and faded in the lane. FORTUNATE ROOSTER never factored while racing five wide. SHOWMETHETRICK trailed five and six wide.
