TEQUILA AT SUNSET rank at the start to be off slow, rallied three wide on the turn, angled out sharply into the stretch then under a strong drive was up in time. CALLER TRUST stumbled at the start, moved up three wide, steadied off the winners heels coming five wide into the stretch then was second best. VIOLET CIRCLE prompted the issue three and four wide, finished strongly. SUEGRA set the pace under pressure, gained clear on the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. NO FLASHLITE shuffled back down the backstretch while on the rail, found her best stride late, three wide. BI ROSE stalked the leaders, three and four wide, failed to respond when asked. PHONE FLARE UP pressed the issue from the inside, faded through the stretch. SATIN ROSE forced the pace along the rail, lacked the needed rally. The rider of CALLER TRUST lodged a claim of foul against the winner alleging interference at the top of the lane. The Stewards reviewed the video tape replays and disqualified TEQUILA AT SUNSET from first and placed her second.
