**Footnotes**

OYKEL BRIDGE stalked the early pace off the rail, took aim nearing the five sixteenths pole, moved to the lead inside the quarter, was urged clear midway on the final turn and under a steady drive to last while flattening stride. LOUD RAVENS settled off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn about the three path and dug in from the head of the lane to reach the withers of the winner at the wire. BEE REGAL, well back inside, improved at the rail on the final turn, eased outward through the lane and got up late for show. SILVER SPELL came in early to take the inside, rated the pace through most of the backstretch, was pressured leaving the five sixteenths pole but caught inside the quarter and leveled off from there. BLACKBERRY WINTER settled back inside, was driven from the five sixteenths pole but proved empty in the stretch. BREWSTER COUNTY settled off the early pace toward mid track then lacked significant response while saving ground on the final turn. CASTELLI'S GOLD was forced outward and into Seeking Magic soon after the start and never factored. KLEINSRIDGE bore out at the break and ran well back off the rail. BILL'S REPRIZED, briefly close, was through after a half mile. SEEKING MAGIC, pinched back early, raced well back and showed very little response to a steady drive.
