Footnotes

CHIGGER ROO settled off the pace toward mid track, bid leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to the front three wide approaching the quarter, drew clear mid turn and dug in under determined handling to hold off the runner-up. TODAY AND ALWAYS settled back toward mid track, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn four wide, took aim a furlong away but hung the length of the stretch. CAPTAIN KIRKLAND dropped back from a brief early lead to give chase, had aim between horses toward the quarter pole and loomed a close factor to the head of the lane before leveling off. BIG AND BRIGHT raced well back off the rail, started a bid toward the quarter pole and was passing tiring rivals while easing outward through the lane. BANXIOUSFORNOTHING, off the pace about the three path, bid at the three eighths pole but lacked further on the final turn. I'M A TERP rated a clear lead off the rail, was pressured leaving the five sixteenths pole, caught approaching the quarter, roughed to a near standstill and gave way from there. FOX DRIVE rated close to the pace inside but was through early. The stewards posted the inquiry though found insufficient cause for change.
