VALS A DOCTOR prompted the pace, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch, held clear under a strong drive. MOVINLIKAWINNER made a clear lead early, dug in around the turn then was all out to hold second. ANNAKOVA moved up just off the rail, finished well. AQUA PIERRA pressed the pace four wide, lacked a closing bid. MY LADY O'WAR stalked the leaders three wide, lacked the needed rally. CHARLIE MY BOY slow to begin then was taken wide, passed tiring rivals. THE BASKET WEAVER saved ground but had no rally. SONG OF VERSAILLES six wide down the backstretch, came four wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. SECRET MISSILE forced the pace inside, tired. WOULDTHISBEMAGIC ducked out late on the backstretch and lost her rider. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident with WOULDTHISBEMAGIC late on the backstretch but took no action.
