Footnotes

HALFWAY HOUSE dueled on a slim lead, dug in around the turn then slowly drew off the last sixteenth. HERE FOR THE MUSIC prompted the issue just off the rail, was on even terms into the stretch, weakened the last sixteenth. WILD MAMBO saved ground staying close, altered four wide in mid stretch and finished well. EYESFORHUMOR with the leaders three wide, lacked a late response. I CONCUR on the rail down the backstretch, eased out four wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. NO BOND PER JUDGE five wide for the first half, dropped down three wide around the turn, had little left for the drive. MR. KNOCK OUT was no factor along the inside. SKIP THE TRIAL a pace factor for a half while four wide, stopped.
