CHARMING SAWYER off a step slow, steadily gained three wide, rallied five wide on the turn then under a strong drive was up in the final strides. HOLY ROLL'EM advanced along the inside, made a clear lead around the turn, led until the final strides. BIG APPLE ALKE four and five wide, closed with a rush through the lane. SOUTHERN FOLLY gained a slim lead down the backstretch, remained a factor on the turn, lacked a closing bid. SWEET HALUCINATION within striking distance three wide, lacked a late response. READY THE CONFETTI forced the issue four wide, lacked the needed late rally. BUSTER DOUGLAS in tight then steadied shortly after the start, was five wide along the backstretch while no factor. ENGLISH ALPHABET alternated on the lead for a half along the rail, gave way around the turn. LOGANS LIL DEVIL never threatened from the inside. CANDY FOR NICO up close for a half along the rail, stopped.
