Footnotes

LEOBUSTER forced the issue from the rail, made the lead on the turn, held clear through the stretch under a drive. FUDGE THE BOOKS in tight after the start, moved up just off the rail and finished willingly. MANDATUM set the pace along the inside, remained a factor on the turn, weakened in the drive. LAC VALENTINE with leaders three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. FIRST AND BAY saved ground, rallied around the turn but failed to sustain his bid. CAYMAN CONDO within striking distance four and five wide, lacked the needed rally. DECOLATOR up close three and four wide, steadily faded. RASCAL CAT broke in a tangle then was squeezed back after the start, never was a factor three and four wide. FORT APACHE STAR was used up after a half while six wide. HE'S RISING off a step slow, showed little from the inside.
