**Footnotes**

SOUTHERN WILL settled back off the rail, bid saving ground leaving the three eighths pole, eased three wide into the stretch, dueled to the front a sixteenth away and dug in determinedly to best the runner-up. SIR FIT'S TOO MUCH rated with the pace two deep, dueled for control past the three eighths pole, held the advantage through the upper stretch but grudgingly ceded the final sixteenth. BUBBA DE FRANCE settled back toward the inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased four wide into the stretch and finished evenly to chase the top two home. CAPTAIN TEN rated well back inside, bid leaving the first turn and closed to the head of the lane before leveling off. BANDI'S LUV rated a slim lead inside, yielded control past the three eighths pole, continued a close factor through the upper stretch, lacked further response, was eased in late yards and vanned off sore. BIG MACHINE dropped back toward the inside early, raced well back off the rail, improved four wide on the final turn and finished evenly in mid track. SIGNATURE RUN was not a factor while mostly saving ground. SANSAR MOUNTAIN was through early. DAYLIGHT STREAKER was through after a half mile. BILLY'S BLESSING rated close through the opening turn, gave chase from the half mile pole then gave way toward the five sixteenths.
