**Footnotes**

MADMAN , clear entering the first turn, set the pace along the rail and dug in tenaciously through the stretch to narrowly prevail. FOR APPEAL , four wide entering the first turn, circled the far turn, pressed the winner and just missed in a game effort. MARQUIS JET prompted the pace outside the winner and weakened. MARTY'S HUNCH stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced wide leaving the far turn and rallied. GERRYMANDER circled the far turn and weakened. PRIZED CONQUEST , no factor, raced evenly. POLISH DYNAMITE hugged the rail entering the stretch and failed to rally. GLORIOUS KING was outrun. DECENT EXPOSURE was outrun. BEARSTEIN dropped back.
